Scholarship General Information

Scholarship Amounts:

Available to all Active Members

A Maximum of \$500.00 – Junior/Community College
A Maximum of \$1,000.00 – Four-year College/University

Available to all Reserve Members

A Maximum of \$250.00 – Junior/Community College
A Maximum of \$500.00 – Four-year College/University

Number of Scholarships to be awarded each Calendar Year:

Based on the number of applications and the amount of money approved by the Anaheim Police Survivors and Scholarship Fund Trustees.

Application Deadline:

April 1, 2009

Recipients:

Recipients will be recommended by the Anaheim Police Honorary Scholarship Committee and approved by the Board of Trustees of Anaheim Police Survivors and Scholarship Fund.

Scholarship:

Scholarships are to be awarded (certificate only) in June. When awards are made, recipients will be notified that funds will be released upon proof of acceptance into a certified college.

Should \$1,000.00 for Active Members or \$ 500.00 for Reserve Members be awarded to a candidate accepted to a senior college or university, who then changes his/her mind and enrolls in a junior college, it is to be understood that the maximum amount awarded to a junior college attendee is \$250.00 for Reserves Members and \$500.00 for Active Members.

Scholarships are limited to four years.

Scholarship Application Criteria

Entering Student (Recent High School Graduate)

1. Must be child (natural or legally adopted) of an Anaheim Police Officer or Reserve Officer.
2. Must have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
3. Must present two letters of recommendation from staff members of graduate's high school.
4. Submit short essay (500 words or less) on need for scholarship and goals.
5. Must enroll in at least twelve units.

Continuing Student (Already Enrolled in College Program)

1. Must be child (natural or legally adopted) of an Anaheim Police Officer or Reserve Officer.
2. Must have a cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
3. Submit short essay (500 words or less) on need for scholarship and goals.
4. Must enroll in at least twelve units.

Returning Student (Entering College after a Break in their Educational Experience)

1. Must be child (natural or legally adopted) of an Anaheim Police Officer.
2. Waive Grade Point Average (GPA) requirement; consider maturity factor.
3. Must have letters of recommendation from current employer and adult friend who has known candidate for at least five years.
4. Submit short essay (500 words or less) on need for scholarship and goals.
5. Must enroll in at least twelve units.
